## Silver Service

There is a huge solid silver tray estimated at £2,000 in the Charterhouse **two day** 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> December auction.

"Weighing in at over 10 lbs you have to feel sorry for the domestic staff who would have carried this tray full up with cucumber sandwiches in the summer, mince pies at Christmas, coffee in the morning, tea in the afternoon or an aperitif in the early evening," commented Richard Bromell. "Adding on all that weight and with the butler standing bolt upright it must have been quite back breaking."

The silver tray is hallmarked for London 1895. At 73 cm wide it has a gadroon, shell and acanthus leaf border with a presentation inscription to the Rev Alexander Maclaverty. He was vicar at Llangattock-Vibon-Avel, St Maughans and Llanfaenor in Monmouthshire for 43 years and the tray was presented to him by his parishioners and friends in 1917.



Fitted in its own oak box it has had little use of the past years. Lining the box is an old Telegraph newspaper dating back to 1953.
