Items from the estate of the late Dame Elisabeth Frink are included in the Charterhouse two day **14**th **and 15**th **November** auction in Sherborne, Dorset.

Born in 1930 Elisabeth Frink studied at the Guildford School of Art and the Chelsea Schools of Art. Although she produced many drawings and prints she is best known for her outdoor sculpture which include the Dorset Martyrs in Dorchester, Paternoster at Paternoster Square, London and Walking Madonna at Chatsworth House, Derbyshire.

Dame Elisabeth was married three times. The items in the Charterhouse auction come via her son, Lin Jammet, from her marriage to her first husband Michel Jammet.

"It is quite an eclectic selection, as you would expect from a family of artists," commented **Richard Bromell**. "There is period oak and decorative painted Continental furniture,
