

Classic Commuter Bikes at Charterhouse

Six classic commuter motorcycles are going under the hammer at the Charterhouse auction of classic motorcycles and cars being held at Sherborne Castle on Sunday 15th July.

“The six motorcycles have all come from one Somerset collector. He is having a thin out of his extensive collection of motorcycles, all of which are less than 250cc, and many of which have been trusty steeds taking their owners to work for decades.” Commented Matthew Whitney. “He owns about 60 classic motorcycles, but sadly with advancing years and only being able to ride one at a time, he has decided now is the right time to enter them into our specialist auction.”

Entered into the sale are classic motorcycles from the 1950's and 1960's including Ariel, Francis Barnett, Velocette, Lambretta and BSA. These were mainly small engine motorcycles such as the iconic BSA Bantam and the Lambretta LD150. All in restored condition, and ready to be used and taken to classic motorcycle shows, they are estimated from just £600 for a Velocette LE similar to the one used in the popular TV series Heartbeat, up to £1800 for the Lambretta LD.
