Finished in Healey Blue it has a Le Mans louvered bonnet, flat top pistons and 68 spoke chrome wire wheels with period correct cross-ply tyres. Having been a familiar sight on its Somerset roads for decades, it even had the honour of delivering Father Christmas to schools on numerous occasions!
