

Mammoth Three Day Charterhouse Auction

This collection is then followed on with nearly 500 lots of silver, jewellery and watches with lots from £30 to £30,000.

Next up, on Friday 4th, there are just under 600 lots with specialist sales of Asian Arts, antiques and interiors and also a section wine and port. Lots here across all sections are from £30 up to £5,000.

Finally, on **Saturday 5th**, there are 100's more lots. This time, there are model cars, trains, toys, coins, militaria, other collector's items and clocks.
