## A Trio of Thirties Classic Cars at Charterhouse

Of the three cars, the family car is a 1934 Hillman saloon. It was originally purchased from Squires Garage in Castle Cary and has only had four registered owners, all of whom lived in Somerset. Next up is a 1938 Austin Opal tourer, which has only covered 60 miles since a total body off restoration and full engine rebuild by Tim Whellock. Lastly, for the sporting owner, there is a 1936 Wolseley 12/48. This very rare fixed head coach built coupe is 1 of only 98 constructed and was rescued from a chicken shed in the New Forest over 30 years ago and subsequently underwent a full restoration programme.
