

Wine and Whisky but no Song at Auction

The bottle of Bowmore was given to the owner's husband in 1979 as a gift from his employer. Having kept it in a cupboard for many years, it was decided to open the bottle to celebrate the couple's Golden Wedding Anniversary, but sadly he passed away shortly before the date. It then sat in the cupboard for another couple of years

as the owner does not drink alcohol and it was brought into Charterhouse on one of their specialist valuation days for appraisal where she was delighted with the £1,500-2,000* auction estimate.

Also in this specialist auction on Thursday 22nd of over 500 lots, there is also a huge selection of, red, white and rosé wine with cases estimated from just £30* up to single bottles of premium wine such as Chateau Palmer, Latour and d'Yquem, and champagne including Dom Perignon along with cases or vintage port in wooden boxes, with many of the lots being sold without reserve.
