

Fine Wine and Diamonds Sparkle at Charterhouse

The Charterhouse May two day auction includes the contents of a wine cellar a super selection of jewellery and silver.

“This two auction on **Thursday 16th and Friday 17th May** has 1,300 lots estimated from £40 to £18,000,” commented Richard Bromell. “Entries have been consigned to this auction from deceased estates and collectors predominantly in the West Country although it has more of an international feel to it.”

In the wine, port and whisky section there are hundreds of bottles from a Dorset deceased estate. The titled client, who passed away recently, had been enjoying fine wine and port for many years all in moderation of course! The wine and port was mostly bought until the end of the 20th century and was carefully stored the wine on racks.

“It is a great cellar,” commented Paul King, wine expert at Charterhouse. “There is a fabulous selection of wine including some stunning Hermitage from the late 1970’s and early 1980’s along with a super selection of vintage port from the 1950’s and 1960’s.”

In amongst the jewellery, it is a substantial tennis bracelet with 36 brilliant cut diamonds at £15,000-£20,000 which stands out.

However, a collection of jewellery from a Somerset deceased estate has turned up 50 lots which are expected to sell for over £10,000 which includes more affordable items with gold bracelets from £100 and diamond rings up to £1,000 with the collection valued at over £10,000.

In the silver, it was an appointment in London which turned up a large amount of lots. Here, a solid silver figure of a Greyhound, cast in 1968, is estimated at £600-£800.
