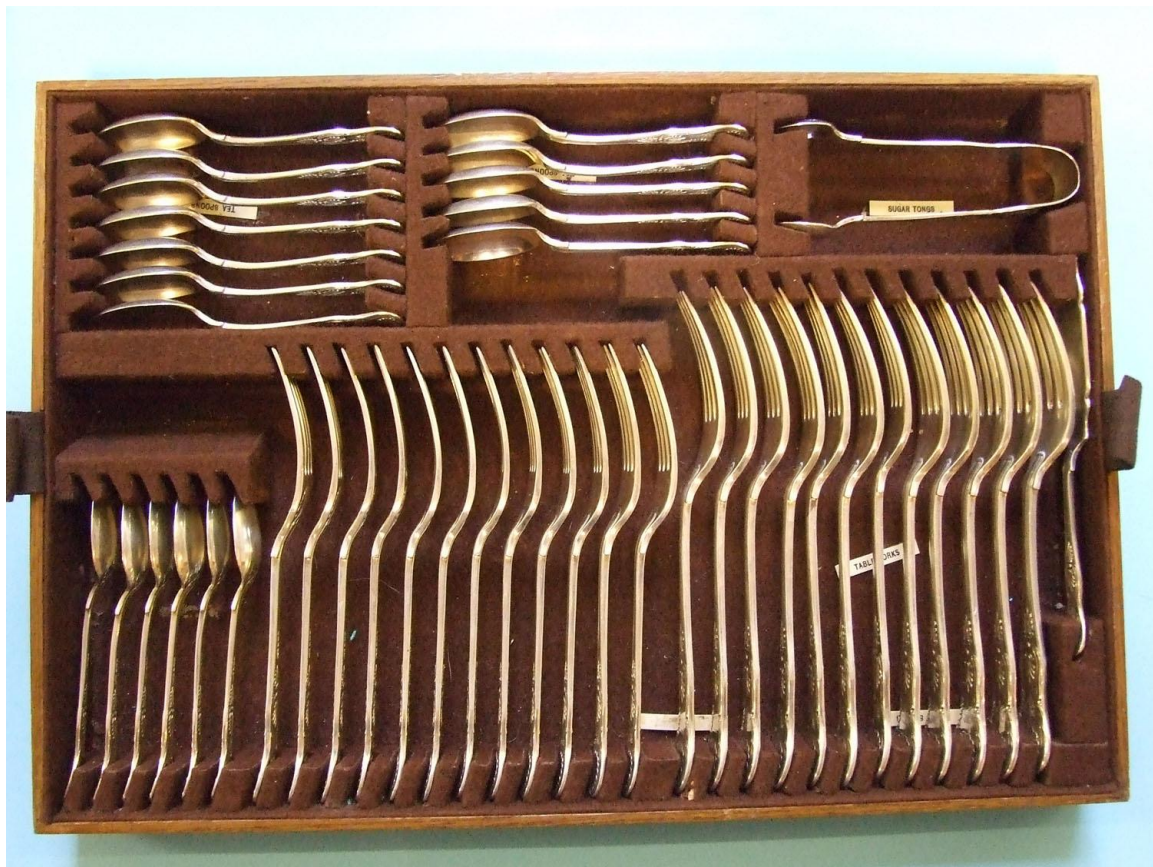


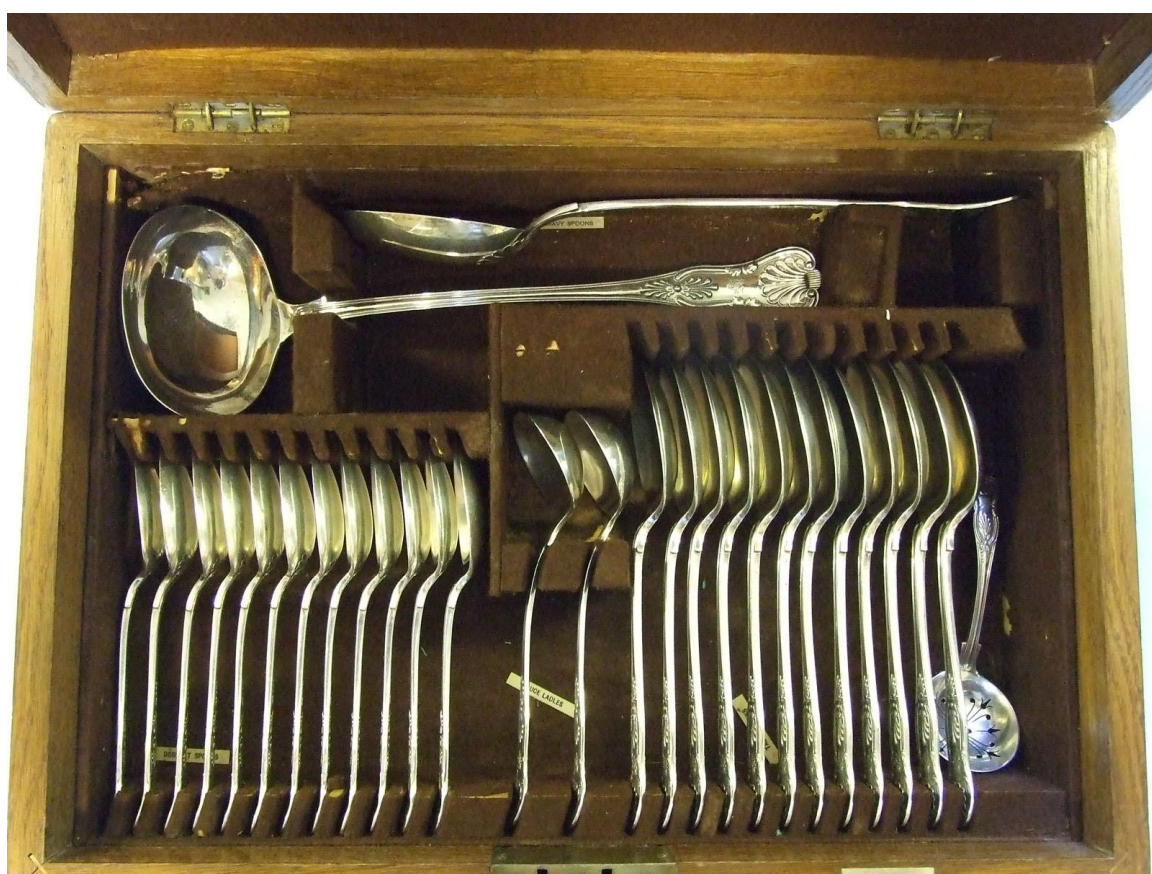
Silver Service at Charterhouse

The Charterhouse February auction of gold, jewellery and silver includes an amazing silver table service of cutlery.

“The table service of silver was a wedding present to the vendors and was purchased from Harrods.” Commented Richard Bromell. “However, the owners who live near Crewkerne have used the service sparingly over their many decades of being happily married and decided it is time for someone else to have the pleasure of owning and using the service on future occasions.”

Rarely do such extensive solid silver services of table cutlery appear on the market. The service being sold by Charterhouse comprises 72 pieces of Old English pattern cutlery and is a 12 place setting with additional pieces including soup and other ladles, a sugar sifter and even a small pair of sugar tongs. Made by Mappin & Webb in 1925, and fitted in the original oak canteen it is estimated to sell for £2,400-2,800.
