

Auction is Wheely Good

Of the three wheeled variety there is a Bob Jackson tricycle with a racing frame and Campagnolo gears, a Higgins Ultralite racing tricycle, but on the other side of the scale, there is a Victorian coach built Bath Chair with cart springs, solid runner tyres and button backed upholstery.

However, if pedal or push power is not for you, then there is a rare 1950 Parker three wheel special vehicle. It has a one off aluminium body, a single headlamp and is powered by an ILO 400cc twin motorcycle engine. Now requiring restoration it will give the new owner a challenge.
