There were some amazing prices achieved in the Charterhouse specialist auction of automobilia on 26th September.

Top lot was a rare and small opaque glass Shell Motor Oil clamshell pump globe. Entered into the auction from a client near Newbury, this sold on the hammer for £8,000.
