**Road Closure for resurfacing works – A30 Kitt Hill Junction Sherborne**

Dorset Highways will be carrying out night road surfacing at the signal junction A30 Kitt Hill from 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> Feb. Starting at 20.00 on the 9<sup>th</sup> and finishing 06.00am on the 11. Full details of the works including the diversion plan are available on the One Network web site [one.network/?tm=GB132458008b](http://one.network/?tm=GB132458008b)

During the closure periods there will be no on-street parking available. Parking restrictions will be imposed to prevent waiting or parking on the roads stated on the diversion plan. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. If a vehicle has been towed the owner will need to contact our towing contractors Bride Valley on 01305 889421. Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

If you live within the closure itself, full access will be available and both footways will be open throughout the closure. Please contact Jason Loibl on 01305 228100 for more information and/or talk to the Dorset Staff, who are undertaking the works.

To help the flow of traffic during the works, drivers are being asked to help by planning ahead and thinking more carefully about their route around the town centre. You may need to use a different route than usual.

Unfortunately, with this sort of work, some inconvenience may be caused but we will ensure that it is kept to a minimum. If you feel the work is likely to cause any particular problems, which could be helped by special arrangements (e.g., for anyone with a mobility problem or for special deliveries you might be expecting), please contact us in advance.

Should you have any problems or reasons for complaint whilst work is going on, it would be helpful if you could let us know at once. We will then be able to ensure that the earliest possible action is taken to overcome them.
