

Lifetime Medal Collection Comes to Charterhouse

A huge single owner medal collection is being sold by Charterhouse in Sherborne on **Wednesday 27th November**.

“The owner, who passed away earlier this year, had been a Charterhouse client for many years and his wife has instructed us to auction his collection without reserve,” commented Richard Bromell.

The earliest medal in the collection is a Waterloo medal awarded to Cpl J Chappel (Coldstream Guards) with the latest medal in the collection a South Atlantic medal awarded to A Green (HMS Fearless). The owner, who travelled extensively for

business, started collecting medals when his wife gave him her late fathers WWII medals and he was immediately bitten by the collecting bug.

Medals from over 160 years are represented with no one particular regiment or campaign or military division collected. There are hundreds of medals from gallantry to coronation medals with the collection being sold nearly 400 lots estimated to sell for £200,000.
